Job Description Summary

Under direction, manages and directs the clinical and/or social services activities of the IDD Division. Provides programmatic and administrative direction in the daily operations of the IDD Division. Responsibilities include supervision and oversight of multiple programs within the eight county service area; supervision of staff; coordination of programs and services; work closely with Regional Office and Community Stakeholders; ensure that programs are in compliance with current guidelines; ensure that service provision is within established waiver guidelines; knowledge of behavior support plans and techniques; knowledge of the NOW and COMP Waivers that serve the IDD population. Some travel is required.

Minimum Qualifications:

Master's Degree in Social Work, Psychology, Counseling, Sociology, Nursing, Vocational Rehabilitation, or a related field. Five or more years of experience in the Developmental Disabilities field and must have supervisory experience. DDP or DDP Eligible.
